

SIMPLY WHAT IS - ART CLASSES (ONLINE LIVE AND PRE-RECORDED)

Participants to Bring to Each Art Class:

Note: A Colour Mixing Chart as a helpful guide will be emailed to you upon booking.

- A small Water Spray Bottle (can be bought from Bunnings, Ikea, supermarkets)
- Old cloths to clean up with: 1 x wet, 1 x dry
- Water container to Clean brushes in
- 3 Small dishes to create Paint Washes in
- Palette (eg a sheet of plastic, ice-cream container lid or art palette) to lay paint out on
- Palette Knife (very handy for different techniques), or use a piece of strong cardboard or plastic, or something to use in a similar way...even a kitchen spatula!
- a Small Sponge (eg kitchen or car) cut into smaller pieces, Or small Sponge brushes (from art/variety stores)

If No Art Box is purchased then please bring the following:

- A set of Paintbrushes (eg 1 x small, 2 x medium, 1 x large)
- small pots/tubes of paint. Primary colours (red, blue, yellow, white, black) and any other colours you like, eg green, turquoise, brown, other variations.
- Art paper to paint acrylic paint on (these come in pads of paper from variety stores, art stores)
- For Abstract & Landscapes Projects Class you may bring 2 x art canvas boards or canvases in small to medium size. Note: this is a 1.5hr class so gauge how much you will paint in this time to choose size of surface to paint on. OR paint on paper.

Hint: (also on Colour Mixing Chart) Blue and red create purple; yellow and blue create green; blue, yellow, red create brown; white creates lighter tones for colours; black creates darker tones of colours. Bring the colour mixing chart with you.
